Visit ancient and principal sites of Eastern Bali with its own artistic remains of its Kingdom

This tour highlights the ancient and historical principal sites of Eastern Bali. Tour Kesiman Village, home of a batik factory where you'll make your own creation. In Klungkung visit Kertha Gosa, an ancient justice hall with its own famous painted ceiling, and lunch at the Maha Giri Restaurant in Rendang Village. Local architecture and villager's daily activities are on full display at Penglipuran Village, while Kehen Temple is a "must-see" with its hillside-ascending courtyards.

Uluwatu Temple Tour - OE26

A visit to one of the most largest Artistic Statue built in South East Asia well known as Garuda Wisnu Kencana and see Pura Luhur Uluwatu by the cliff of Indian ocean.
